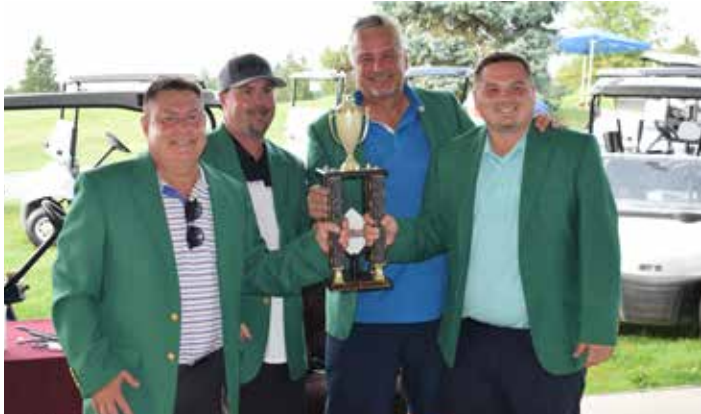

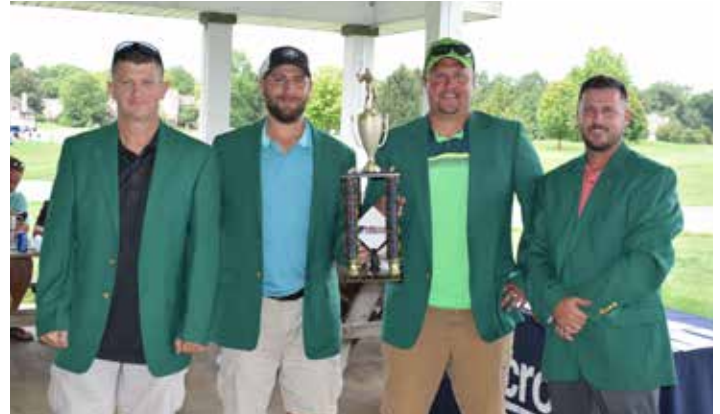
16th Annual Masters Golf Outing

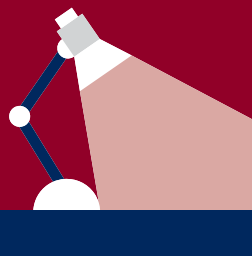

SEVERAL LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS AWARD HILLCROFT GRANT FUNDING

Hillcroft Services, Inc. was fortunate enough to be awarded several grants over the past few months for various needs throughout our agency.

We received \$15,187 from The Community Foundation of Muncie & Delaware County to help us keep pace with our ever-growing Music Therapy program. This allowed us to purchase much needed replacement and additional equipment for our clients and staff to utilize.

Our newest service, the Recreation Therapy program, received \$15,000 from the Ball Brothers Foundation and \$1,000 courtesy of The Friends of Muncie Endurathon. These grants have helped us purchase necessary equipment for this program to meet the individual needs of our clients in order to keep them living active and healthy lives.

Due to the unexpected costs of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) during the COVID-19 pandemic, we were awarded emergency grants of \$5,000 from First Merchants Bank and \$2,000 from The Community Foundation of Muncie & Delaware County to assist us with the costs involved in purchasing PPE to help ensure the safety and well-being of our staff and clients. Additional masks donated by The Arc of Indiana and Project Benny: Masks for Muncie were also gladly accepted.

We are so thankful for the generosity and continued partnerships with these organizations and their commitment to our mission and improving the overall quality of life in our community through philanthropy and leadership.
